- Ensuring recruitment of personnel with appropriate ability, skill and aptitude according to their employment role.
- Providing a safety management system throughout the entire company and on all vessels.
- Monitoring, auditing, inspecting and taking corrective actions to health and safety matters.
- Constant improvement of our Health and Safety management through training programmes to ensure awareness and capability amongst employees and operation throughout the entire company.
- Managing subcontractors and suppliers to ensure that their activities meet Alpha Marine's Health & Safety requirements as a minimum.
- Our efforts are committed primarily at prevention of errors, hazardous situations and incidents causing injury and ill health. Our target is zero accidents in the workplace.

This policy is communicated to all employees and organisations working on Alpha Marine's behalf.
